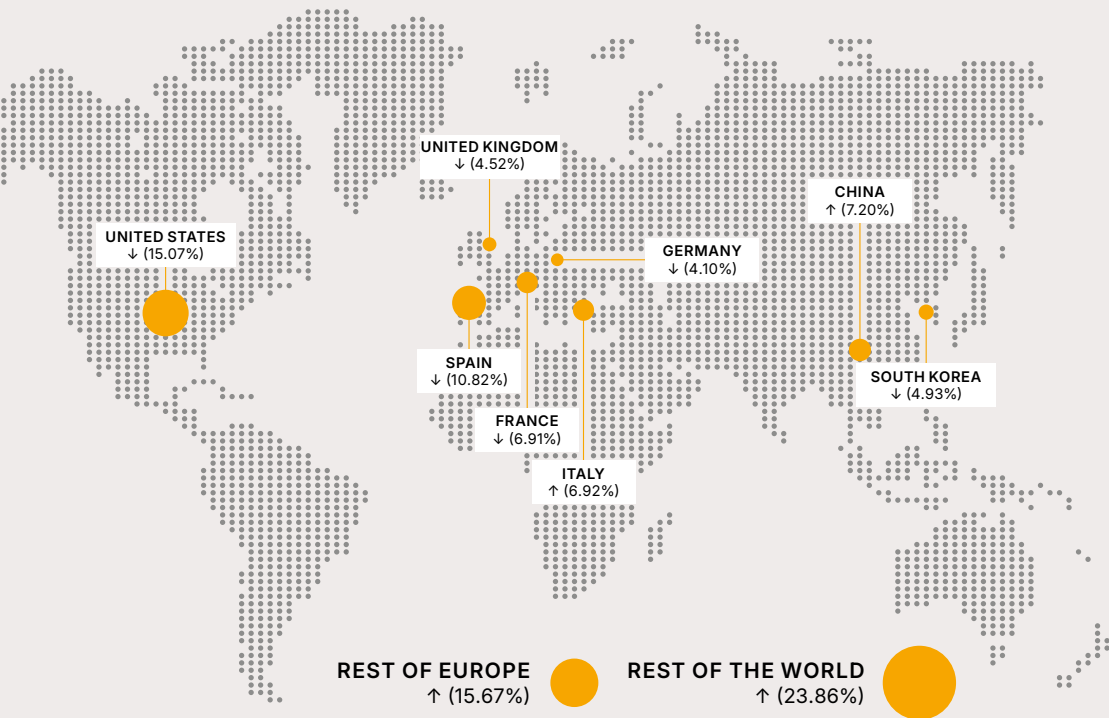

# WE ARE THE PEOPLE

## SANT JORDI

For Sant Jordi, **3,884 people called Jordi or Jordina** in any language visited the Basilica for free, 34.44% more than the previous year. The audiovisual installation "**Llum primigènia**" (Primeval Light) reinterpreted the legend of Saint George with contemporary visual language, using light as a symbol of regeneration.

## CONTINUOUS UPDATES

The Sagrada Família museum inaugurated the remodelled room called "**Antoni Gaudí. Humanity and spirituality**", which gives visitors an intimate look at the Catalan architect. Through photos, models and unpublished materials, the space explores his personality, beliefs and views on architecture. This space aims to delve deeper into Gaudí's human and spiritual legacy and enrich visitors' experience at the Basilica.

## OPEN DOORS DAYS

In 2025, **8,500 tickets** were given out in a draw for the Santa Eulàlia Open Doors Days and **20,000** for the Open Doors Days for the Mercè festivities.

Through the programme of social visits, **326 tours** were hosted with a total of 6,320 people from socially vulnerable groups.

Regarding family activities designed to open up the Temple to the little ones, a total of 1,035 children took part in children's workshops and activities for Easter and Christmas, as well as the "Be like Gaudí for a day; build the tower of Barnabas" workshop.

## CONCERTS

In addition to the traditional Easter and Christmas concerts, the Basilica also hosted a concert of Mozart's *Requiem* in collaboration with the Liceu, a carolling concert and the international concert of European children's choirs, as part of a programme commemorating the **hundredth anniversary of Antoni Gaudí's death**. The event was a tribute to the thousandth anniversary of Montserrat. In total, 9,114 people took part in these musical experiences.

We welcomed **135,409 foreign schoolchildren** and **56,101 Spanish students**.

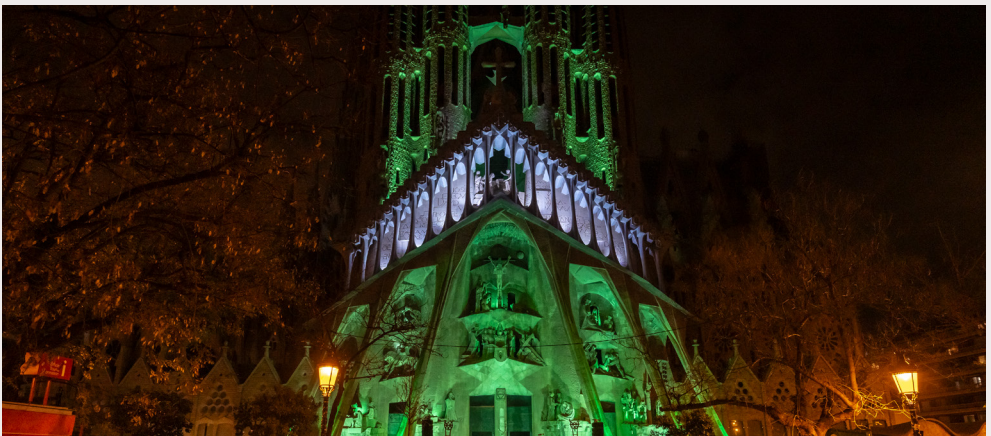

# WE ARE SOCIAL ACTION FUND

The Junta Constructora del Temple Expiatori de la Sagrada Família opened the **third call for the Social Action Fund (SAF)**, reaffirming its commitment to supporting third-sector organisations. In order to reach as many projects as possible and have an even greater impact on society, the amount earmarked was increased **40% compared to 2024**. Plus, the scope was expanded to include the dioceses of Terrassa and Sant Feliu de Llobregat, in the Barcelona Ecclesiastical Province.

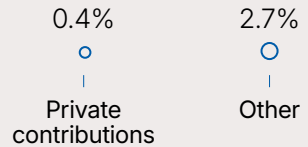
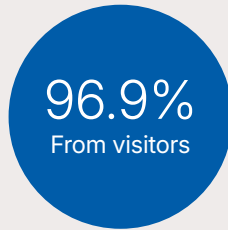

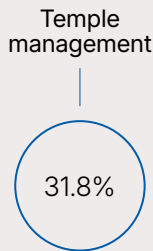
**INCOME**

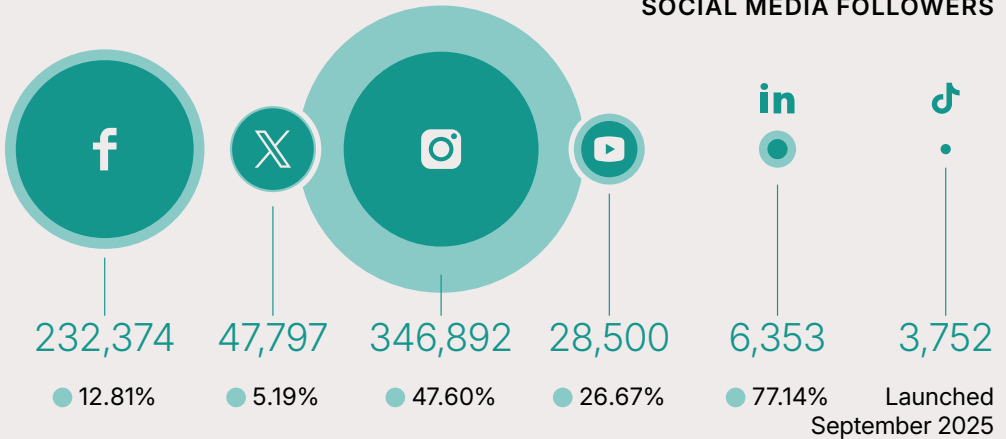
